



THIRD GRADE SUPPLIES 2011-2012

Some of these supplies may need to be replenished throughout the year.

pencils (Ticonderoga--works best in pencil sharpener)
pencil box (not the large kind)
package dry erase markers (wide)
1 sock to use as an eraser on dry-erase board
5 folders (binder in middle and pockets--Please get 5 colors that are NOT red. I will supply a RED folder that we will keep at school.)
1 - 2" three-ring binder with pockets (L.A.)
1 - 1" three-ring binder (Latin)
notebook dividers
ruler*
2 spiral notebooks (wide rule)
scissors
crayons (no bigger than 48)
dictionary (recommended: Webster's New World Dictionary)
1 package glue sticks*
Elmer's Glue*
3x5 cards w/box (Latin) (may use last year's)
photo book to hold 3x5 cards (Latin) (may use last year's)
1"x8"x9" binder for Bible cards (students may use a sibling's from the previous year or order one from school)
2 copy paper
2 Clorox wipes
2 Kleenex

Art Supplies* Needed: colored pencils, markers (8-pack of Crayola), scissors, ruler, Elmer's glue, black Sharpie markers (1 fine and 1 ultra-fine), watercolors (in tray, not tubes), 2 glue sticks (will need to be replenished after Christmas break), oil pastels, personal paintbrushes (optional), package of cardstock. Art supplies need to be stored in some sort of box. A photo storage box works well and stacks nicely in the classroom.

Oil pastels may be purchased from Mrs. Lynam for \$1.50.
Personal art supplies are available for students to use in other classes as needed.

Also Needed: plastic bottle caps for some upcoming art projects. This would include caps off of bottled water, 2-liters, plastic soda bottles, glass bottles, etc. These can be brought in and placed in the designated container.
